- \bullet This report is an authoritative declaration from the government of India. $\ensuremath{^{\backslash n}}$
- The United States has been India's biggest supplier of weapons platforms over the past three years.
- \bullet It is followed by Russia, Israel and France in that order. $\ensuremath{\backslash n}$
- India concluded contracts worth around Rs 29 crore with the US during 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16. $\$

- \bullet The report details the extent to which orders for "indigenous" weapon systems and equipment actually pay for imported equipment. $\$

- e.g Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd retains the import content of the Sukhoi-30MKI fighter at 44%, even after building it in India under licence for over a decade.
