• A seven-year-old student of Ryan International School, Gurugram, Haryana was found dead in the school campus.

• The Gurugram Police arrested a school bus conductor in connection with the murder.

• However, after the investigation was transferred to the CBI, it came to light that a Class 11 student had committed the murder.

• He had allegedly killed his junior to postpone a parent-teacher meeting and exams.

• The CBI for its part did not find any evidence against the accused bus conductor.

What are the flaws in the investigative mechanism?

- **Procedure** The turn of events with the incident reveals the sheer <u>insensitivity</u> with which investigating agencies deal with such situations.
- The speed with which the accused was identified, but wrongly, brings out the <u>lack of professional competence</u> and insensitivity.

- A major drawback with the current system is that the investigation authorities <u>first arrest and then investigate</u>.
- Needless to say, innocent victims are caught hold of when the police wanted to shield someone.

- <u>Innocent victims</u> are also sometimes forced to confess, only to show the investigative prowess when the real accused cannot be identified.
- \bullet The consequences for the bus conductor and his family if the investigation had not been transferred to the CBI cannot be ignored in this case. \n
- **Skills** Our investigation agencies fall short in several ways, and the prime drawback is that they possess scant <u>knowledge of the law.</u>
- \bullet Agencies also lack <u>professional skills</u> and are not adept at using <u>technology</u>. \n
- This makes it easy to arrest, extract a confession, then proceed to create evidence and go to trial.

• **Social** - Factors of <u>caste and creed</u> also find presence in the investigation process.

- There are cases where investigators are hand-picked for particular cases to achieve a particular result favouring a particular group.
- Political The political class is using investigating agencies as tools for partisan political objectives.
- \bullet The benefits of extension of service and grant of permanent status are offered to those who oblige with the political class. \n
