Virtual Aadhaar ID

- UIDAI has introduced the concept of a virtual ID which an Aadhaar holder can use in lieu of his/her Aadhaar number at the time of authentication, besides sharing of 'limited KYC' with certain agencies

\n

- A Virtual ID (VID) will be a temporary 16-digit random number mapped with the Aadhaar number.

\n

- There can only be one active and valid VID for an Aadhaar number at any given time and it will not be possible to derive the Aadhaar number from VID.

\n

- The VID authentication will be similar to using Aadhaar numbers and VID is temporary, agencies will not be able to use it for de-duplication.

\n

- Only the Aadhaar holder will be able to generate a VID, including authentication user agencies (AUAs), can do it on their behalf.

- Pre-Retirement Counselling (PRC) Workshop 'Sankalp' for the retiring employees of Ministries/Departments was organised by the Department of Pensions & Pensioners' Welfare (DOP&PW).

Largest prime number

- A very big number over 23 million digits long has discovered to be the “largest known prime number”.

- This number was discovered using a software called GIMPS.

- A prime number is a number that can only be divided by itself and by 1. For example: 2, 3, 5, 7, 11, and so on.

- Prime numbers are used in Cryptography (the study of secret messaging, involves sharing information via secret codes), credit cards, cell phones, all depend on cryptography.
