The classification of Indian cities is used to allocate House Rent Allowance (HRA). The present system of X,Y,Z more commonly known as Tier I, Tier II and Tier III cities was classified by 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission based on population.

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Urban Agglomeration is a census term used to denote a continuous urban spread constituting a town and its adjoining outgrowths (OGs), or two or more physically contiguous towns together.

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An Urban Agglomeration must consist of at least a statutory town and its total population should not be less than 20,000 as per the 2001 Census, where as cities with population of 100,000 and above are classified as Tier I.
