- Solar radiation, which carries quantities of x-rays and ultra-violet, can cause cancers and damage DNA.

- The Earth's magnetic field protects biological entities from the potentially dangerous effects of such solar activity by capturing charged particles in the upper atmosphere.

- The region where charged particles are captured is called as the Van Allen belt.
