### State Funeral

- According to the Flag Code of India, the national flag is flown at half-mast across India in the event of the death of the following constitutional authorities
  - *Sitting & former President,*
  - *Prime Minister, and*
  - *Vice-President.*
- In the case of the death of a union cabinet minister, the flag is flown at half-mast in Delhi and state capitals.
- For the death of a chief minister of a state or union territory, the flag is flown at half-mast across the entire state or union territory.
- The flag is also flown at half-mast in Delhi when the Chief Justice of India or the Lok Sabha Speaker dies.
- The Flag Code of India also states that the flag should not be flown at half-mast unless instructed by the Government of India.

- **Prepared by** - *Department of Administration Reforms and Public Grievances, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions. (statement 3 is incorrect)*
