- **NPAs** They are loans or advances that have not been paid back on time, or that have stopped generating income for the lender.
- **Substandard asset** An asset that has been classified as an NPA for 12 months or less.(*Statement 1 is incorrect*)
- **Doubtful asset** An asset that has remained in the substandard category for 12 months. *(Statement 2 is incorrect)*
