Extension Reforms (ATMA) Scheme

- It is a *Centrally Sponsored Scheme* that promotes decentralized and farmer-friendly extension system in the country. *(Statement 1 is incorrect)*.
- It is presently is being implemented in 739 districts (Total 788 districts in India) of 28 states & 5 UTs in the country. (Statement 2 is incorrect).
- 4) The term, Spiti Valley often recently seen in news is located in which of the following states?
 - a. Arunachal Pradesh
 - b. Uttarakhand
 - c. Jammu & Kashmir

Answer: d

Spiti Valley

- It is a cold desert mountain valley located in *Himachal Pradesh*.
- Spiti means the "the middle land" the land between India and Tibet.
- **Bordered by -** Ladakh in the northern side, Tibet in the East, Kinnaur in the South-East and Kullu valley in the North.
- Highest point Kunzum La
- Language Natives communicate in Stod Bhoti, a subgroup of Tibetic languages spoken in Lahaul and Spiti.
- 5) Consider the following statements:

Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD) is celebrated on 9th January biennially to mark the contribution of Overseas Indian community in the development of India.

Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD)

- It is celebrated on *9th January biennially* to mark the contribution of Overseas Indian community in the development of India.
- It is celebrated *annually since 2003*. The format was revised in 2015 to a biennial event.
- January 9 is chosen because it marks 1915, when *Mahatma Gandhi* returned to India from South Africa.

PBD, 2025

- The 18th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention (PBD), 2025 was held in partnership with the Government of Odisha in Bhubaneshwar, Odisha from 8 to 10 January 2025.
- This was the *first PBD to be held in Eastern India*. This approach is in line with Government of India's focus on 'Purvodaya'.
- Theme "Diaspora's Contribution to a Viksit Bharat".
