Katarniaghat Wildlife Sanctuary (KWS):

- KWS is a protected area in the <u>Upper Gangetic plain of Uttar Pradesh</u> which was stablished under the 'Project Tiger' initiative in 1987. Statement 1 is correct.
- Katarniaghat is <u>located in the Bahraich district of Uttar Pradesh</u>, <u>whereby it shares an international border with Nepal</u>. Statement 3 is not correct.
- The Katerniaghat Forest provides strategic connectivity between tiger habitats of Dudhwa and Kishanpur in India and the Bardia National Park in Nepal.
- It is home to a number of <u>endangered species including gharial, tiger, rhino, Gangetic dolphin, swamp deer, hispid hare, Bengal florican, and the white-backed and long-billed vultures</u>. Statement 2 is correct.
- Its fragile Terai ecosystem comprises a mosaic of sal and teak forests, lush grasslands, numerous swamps and wetlands.

Sovereign Green Bonds:

- Green bonds are <u>debt instruments issued by governments</u>, <u>corporations</u>, <u>and multilateral banks to raise funds for projects that reduce emissions or enhance climate resilience</u>. Statement 1 is correct.
- In India, the framework for Sovereign Green Bonds was issued by the government in November 2022, aiming to mobilize resources for green infrastructure and reduce the economy's carbon intensity.
- The <u>Department of Economic Affairs (DEA) under the Ministry of Finance</u> (not RBI) is <u>responsible for overseeing the allocation of proceeds</u> from Sovereign Green Bonds. Statement 2 is not correct.

Species and their IUCN Conservation Status:

- The Gharial (Gavialis gangeticus), also known as fish-eating crocodile, is a crocodilian in the family Gavialidae and among the longest of all living crocodilians. It is listed as *Critically Endangered on the IUCN Red List*. Pair 1 is not correct.
- The Bengal florican (Houbaropsis bengalensis), also called the Bengal bustard, is a bustard species native to the Indian subcontinent, Cambodia, and Vietnam. It is listed <u>as Critically Endangered on the IUCN Red List</u>. Pair 2 is correct.
- The Barasingha (Rucervus duvaucelii), also known as the swamp deer, is a deer species distributed in the Indian subcontinent. <u>It is listed as Vulnerable on the IUCN Red List</u>. Pair 3 is correct.
- The Gangetic dolphin, also known as the Ganges river dolphin, is an <u>endangered species living in the Ganges</u> and related rivers of India, Nepal, and Bangladesh. Pair 4 is correct.

- This Exercise <u>reaffirmed India's commitment to</u> engage with the regional Navies to maintain <u>Security and Growth for All in the Region</u> (SAGAR).

Nanha Sa Dil:

- Nanha Sa Dil is a unique Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative by Coal India Limited (CIL) in collaboration with the Sri Sathya Sai Health & Education Trust (SSSHEt). **Statement 1 is correct.**
- The initiative aims to provide life-saving surgeries for children suffering from Congenital Heart Disease (CHD) and focuses on early diagnosis, screening, and treatment of CHD in communities that often lack resources for specialized healthcare. **Statement 2 is correct.**
- Since its launch on March 7, 2024, the Nanha Sa Dil project has already saved over 250 children through CHD surgeries.
- Now, CIL is expanding the initiative to include beneficiaries across multiple states through its subsidiaries, including CCL, NCL, and SECL
