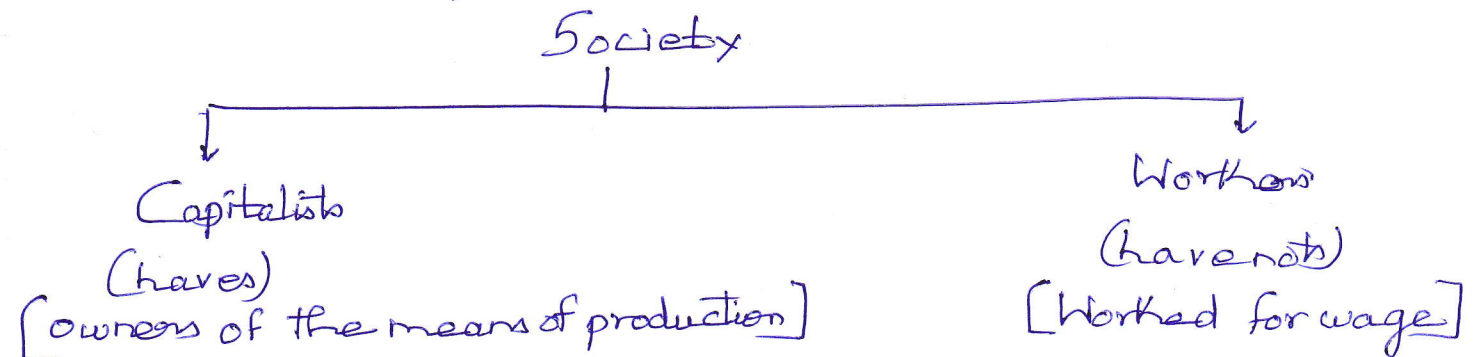


## \* Division of Society

→ The system of society that came into force as the result of industrialisation was called 'Industrial Capitalism'.

⇒ The society was divided into two:



→ This resulted in the concentration of economic power to the capitalists, which led to social inequalities and created a wide gap between the capitalists and the rest of the population.

## \* Urbanisation

→ Before the birth of Industrial Revolution, the life of the people revolved around the villages and their land.

→ People were directly or indirectly connected to land.

→ But, industrial revolution resulted a change in the scenario - where people's lives started to revolve around the cities.

→ People started to migrate to the cities in huge numbers for in search of labour.

→ This led to a rapid urbanisation of the cities.
