1-) Abraham accord in sept 2020 under US president Trump played a pivotal role to acknowledge and establish formal relations of Israel with its neighbour UAE.

3-) In terms of bilateral relations whether Israel, UAE, USA all are India's reliable and trusted partners. In terms of technology, defence, trade.

4-) Tech cooperation b/w Israel and UAE has been growing. UAE aims for 1 trillion dollar activity with Israel by 2031.

5-) India and Israel face similar challenges from radicalism and terrorism both country share deep engagement in defence to deal effectively.

(2) All these factors like bilateral relation, trade, defence made it possible for India to explore larger aspect with all 4 countries.

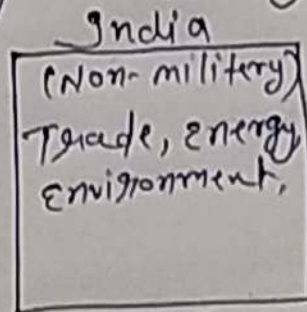
The group of 4 countries (India, Israel, UAE, USA) is being termed a new Quad partner.
