Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), at least 100 days guaranteed wage employment in a fiscal is provided to any rural household whose Adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work on demand. The scheme ranked as World largest Sube work Programme by World bank in 2015. It is provide Social Security to 15% of Our Country's Population.

Problems faced by MGNREGA Scheme

1) From financial 2015 to 2018, low allocation of fund to this scheme in FY 2019, the allocation increases but does not meets the demand.

2) Late allocation of wages

Most of MGNREGA workers Agri-labours, they take part in MGNREGA work for financial stability.

2) Reduce "Over burden" of Scheme by provide employments to rural educated youths to other sectors, because most of MURENA works in between 18-30 years of age, 36% of them are educated.

3) Direct Benefit Transfer implemented efficiently to reduce the presence of Middle Men.
