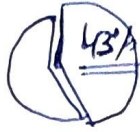

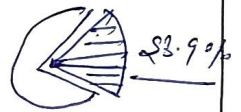

Reverse Migration can influence the country's direction with large impact.

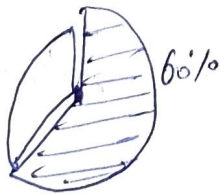
