- first to create SoPs for hospitals & quarantines

② BSF / Border Security Force

- distribution of ration & emergency items
- medical camps, mask distribution

③ CRPF / Central Reserve Police Force

→ Set up help lines, quick-reaction teams
→ community work, HDU, ICU beds

④ CISF / Central Industrial Security Force

→ protective gear & healthcare equipment
to all its personnel
→ Isolation facilities in all CISF units

⑤ ^{AR,} SSB, NSG, RPF are also acting in their
suit in the battle against covid.

⑥ NDRF / National Disaster Response Force

→ Rescue & relief operations, training
the state disaster response force
→ Testing the immigration officials
→ NDRF personnel are wholly drawn from
CAPFs are trained & equipped during
CBRN emergencies
