

Since the Central Asian region remains significant in India's strategic thinking, the engagement with the region remains crucial. Explain

Aus. The central Asian countries - Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan are landlocked by Russia, China, Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iran, Caspian sea and Europe. Because of its geographical location, India was not able to grow economically from central Asian countries due to lack of connectivity.

All central Asian countries were earlier part of USSR.

Hence Russia has political and military influence over it.

But still India also shares a close connection with central Asian countries.

India's close connection:

1) Civilisational - Due to ancient silk route, Buddhism, Islam, the countries share a close cultural heritage with India. The first Mughal emperor of India - Babar was from Uzbekistan.

2) Cultural link - We deploy soft power in these countries since they like cladical art forms, Bollywood movies, Indian foods and our culture.

Significance of Central Asian Countries:

- 1) They are rich in natural resources like oil and gas → Uranium, Metals, Minerals like base earth metals. They have hydro power potential.

But we have certain constraint in terms of connectivity:

- 1) All central Asian are landlocked and Caspian sea is also not open so
 2) Since Wakhan Corridor is occupied by Pak, India lacks connectivity through Afghanistan

Our only way is through Iran. We have few ambitious projects in connecting with Iran. They are Chabahar Port in Iran and TATTC (Tatvanoti and North-south Transport Corridor) through Babol-e-Abbas port of Iran.

India challenges:

- 1) After us left Afghanistan, the region has been dominated by Russia, China and Pak. This affects India's problem in LOC, LAC and Pak occupied Jammu and Kashmir. The relationship between India and Iran was affected by Nuclear sanctions imposed by US and India was faced FDI blockade.

India's Move:

India needs to concentrate geopolitically than geoeconomically in Central Asia Region.

Sino-Russia is threatened by Chinese influence in their region, both countries have Joint defense production and Tribalized Military exercise to protect India's interest. This might gain mutual gains but non-engagement would be costly. Hence India has conducted virtual summit on Republic day by inviting all Central Asian countries as chief guest. This will develop the engagement in Central Asia Region.
