India is set to take up the Presidency of G-20 from December 2022. It acts as a global platform to project India as a global diplomat.

The G-20 The grouping comprises of 80% of world trade, 65% of population and 90% of world's GDP.

The G-20 consists of UNSC permanent members, BRICS and industrialised G7 countries and EU as member.

Instrument of global governance

① India can use G20 to display the success achieved such as administering 200 crore vaccines, achieving the National Determined commitments of 40% of electricity

from renewables and third highest ~~through~~
unicorn start up country. This can send
messages to countries of Latin America.

The G20 summit happening outside
Delhi has great value to promote tourism
in India.

② The IBSA countries (Indonesia, India, Brazil
South Africa) are set to take up presidency
till 2025. G20 can be used as a tool
to address the developing world challenges.

③ India must represent non-G20 members
such as African Union and upgrade their
position from observer to member.

Challenges India China border dispute, US-
China trade war, Ukraine conflicts can dilute
our ambitions.

Nevertheless, India along with IBSA
are confident for a turnaround with
developing countries as a global hub.
