India abstained the UNSC resolutions
condemning Russia over annexation of four
provinces of Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia
and Kherson. Also the PM stressed that today's
era is not ~~an~~ era of war.

Regarding our stand

Sanctions with looming sanctions over Russia, it became
our third biggest oil supplier. The oil
supply increased by over 10 times. The coal
supply also increased by 4 times since the
war. Though India gains from Russia it
has dented our image as peace provider.

Global supplies

The supply disruptions have induced
fertiliser shortage which led to food inflation
to 7.3% as India and an embracing
global recession.

China's threats

The ongoing Russia action by west has worsened the ~~Sino~~ Sino-Russian relationship. Russia can counter our actions as we are in Quid. This can become adverse for us in case of a future conflict in the Himalayas.

Foreign Policy India Russia had aimed to strengthen bilateral relations which was welcomed by USA at the UN without Russian reservations. The essence of Gandhi's doctrine of non interference and respecting sovereignty must be social.

India knows the worth of colonisation. The bombings on Ukraine civilians can be condemned by India which will not create any negative repercussions. India vouches for dialogue and diplomacy in this conflict.
