A number of nations from the Commonwealth and Bangladesh have adopted Basic structure doctrine in their Constitution following the glory of the principle in India.

Basic Structure Doctrine - The safeguard

Basic structure doctrine though not defined, aims to safeguard the integrity and stability of the constitutional framework. It has its core principles and values from constitutional principles and safeguards people from institutionalising tyranny and autocracy. The doctrine emerged from a slew of judgements starting from Shankari Prasad case and Golak Nath, which made the action of executive on legislatures are ruled.

Yet, the subsequent cases settled and solidified the doctrine, Kesavananda Bharathi, Indira Gandhi case, Women Reservation.

It had saved many state legislatures from arbitrary dissolution from the centre and the right of a commoner to approach judicial review.

It safeguards India becoming from a autocratic state and also ensure equality of opportunities.

Future The Doctrine is an evolving concept and it takes different shapes depending upon the events. It will necessary be the poster of judicial innovation in India.
