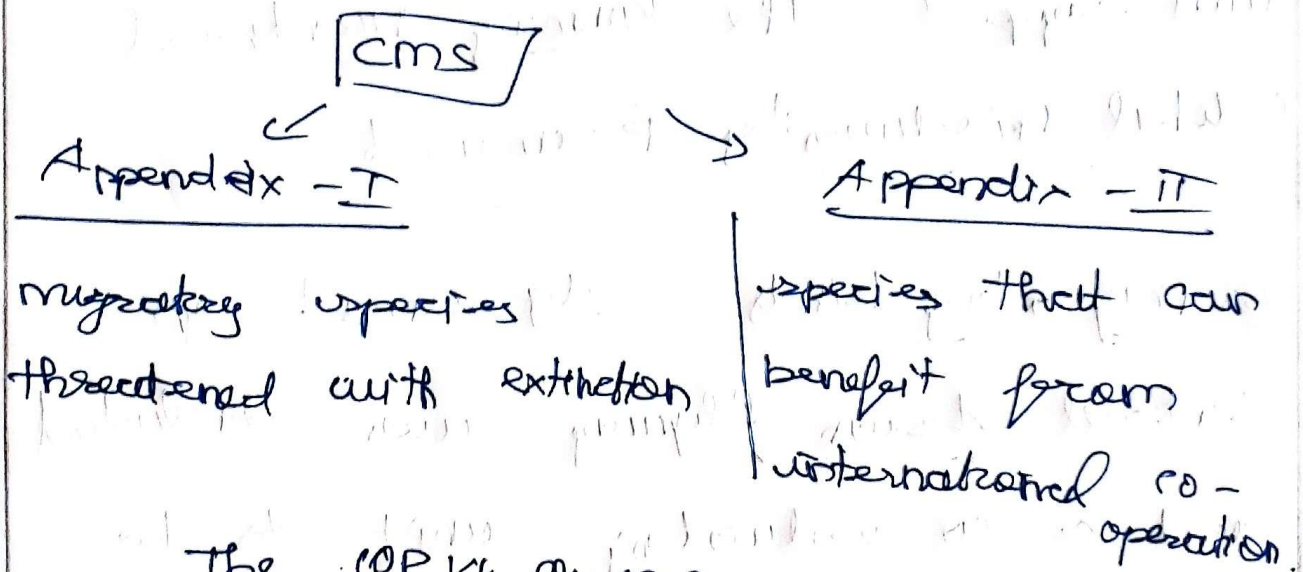


CMS provides global platform for conservation & sust. use of migratory animals & habitats. Enumerate takeaways to COP 14.

Key takeaways of the summit

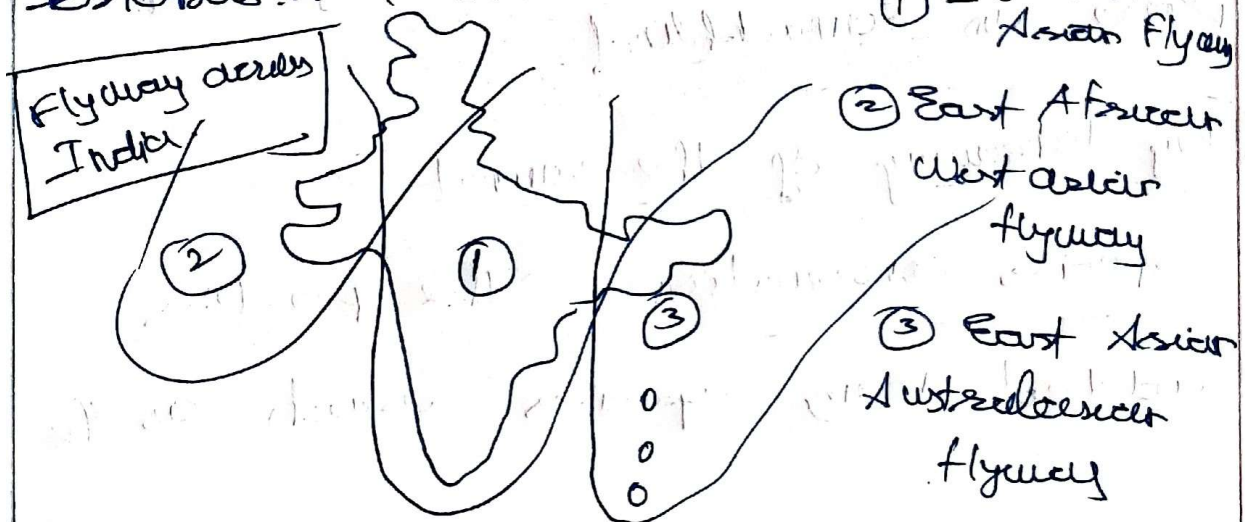
Species conservation The parties added many species such as the
