

Discuss the framework for improving the governance of non-govt organisation in the country.

According to MOSPI report the total no. of non-govt organisation (NGOs) are approx. 31.7 lakh registered societies and get a sum of salary, wage and allowance & etc of approx Rs 4,229 crore.

Why need a framework?

→ According to National Non-profit Institution (NNPI) the:

- no of NGOs is increasing every year

↳ From 1971 to 1982

↳ 2,179 lakh NGOs were reg.

↳ 1982 to 1990 = 11.22 lakh NGOs were registered

and from 1990 to 2000 approx

11.35 lakh societies were formed

↳ the societies include NGOs, BCEI, hospitals, and educational institution & etc.

→ Funding from Foreign and other institution may lead to threat to nation with bad intention and ideology.

* Framework for Improving:

⇒ Proper Data:

↳ Govt ~~are~~ (both State Govt & Central Govt) need to keep ~~data~~ a record of proper data

↳ The Data to be digitised and updated

↳ Data to be segregated and to be kept in organised manner.

⇒ democratic functioning:

↳ the Board decision makers to be appointed based on qualification and need to have certain regulation.

⇒ Funding Source:

↳ A/c to 2012 survey of MPI's the public source therefore there is sufficient public stake is efficient and transparent functioning of the NBO's sector.

⇒ Credibility to entire NBO:

↳ increase and improvement in governance and regulation is essential.

↳ Can be listed in Social Stock Exchange

⇒ Registration!

↳ proper categories and data and other details to be maintained at the time of registration.

↳ the data and details to be updated on time.

↳ Improving governance and service delivery leads to improvement in ease of doing business.

A way Forward:

→ State Govt can implement the laws and regulations.

↳ Since it is under Entry 32 of State list:

→ Central Govt can make a model law and force to implement it.
