Ans. Cyber crime is the crimes related to the internet, social media etc. In the recent years there have been an increase in the rate of cyber crimes (2017 = 12000 cases and 2020 = 50000 cases).

To deal with cyber crime the state and centre should come together with some solid cyber infrastructure to easily handle and take action upon cyber crimes.
