(i) With an increasing numbers of users, devices and programs in the modern enterprise, combined with the increased deluge of data - much of which is sensitive or confidential - the importance of cyber security continues to grow.

(ii) India ranks high on a list of countries with data breaches compromising the privacy of individuals.

(iii) The recent cyber attacks on the fracking gas stations all over the country showed how vulnerable our IT infrastructure can be.

(iv) More than 60,000 cyber attacks were recorded in India in the last years, including one on the computer system of Air India, in which hackers managed to access the personal and financial information of 4.5 million customers worldwide.
