

(17) The constructive role of Department related standing committee improves the efficiency of law making process in the country Analyse.

Polity

Department related standing committees (DRSC) constituted by Speaker / chairman to support parliament on various issues like legislation, Budget proposal, policy thinking etc.

As parliament neither have time & expertise to make detailed discuss on above mentioned things

24 DRSC's can improve efficiency of law making

- Can give suggestion & various dimension on bills like workers protection, Farm bills where legislation failed to
- Detailed deliberation avoids hasty & incomplete bills to pass in parlour
Ex:- Farms act, government take back & created embarrassment

- Representation from various parties based on their strength truly make legislation democratic
- With reduced parliamentary procedure 47% for Lok Sabha & 42% in R.S
DRSC's truly add value to the legislation

However percentage of bills referred to DRSC's during tenure of 14th to 18th L.S has been 60% & 27% respectively skipping various bill to send to DRSC's pressure from party whip affect parliamentary liberty

Following steps can increase DRSC's efficiency

→ compulsory reference to DRSC's on every bill & speaker/chairman to give reasons on exception

→ no whip of party would apply

→ fixed timeline on recommended bill

→ Increasing tenure to 2 years as recommended by R.S secretariat

The purpose of DRSC's to Uphold executive responsibility to Parliament only possible if they are given necessary tool
