India's urban population is on the rise. 35% of population resides in cities and sound solid waste management is paramount.

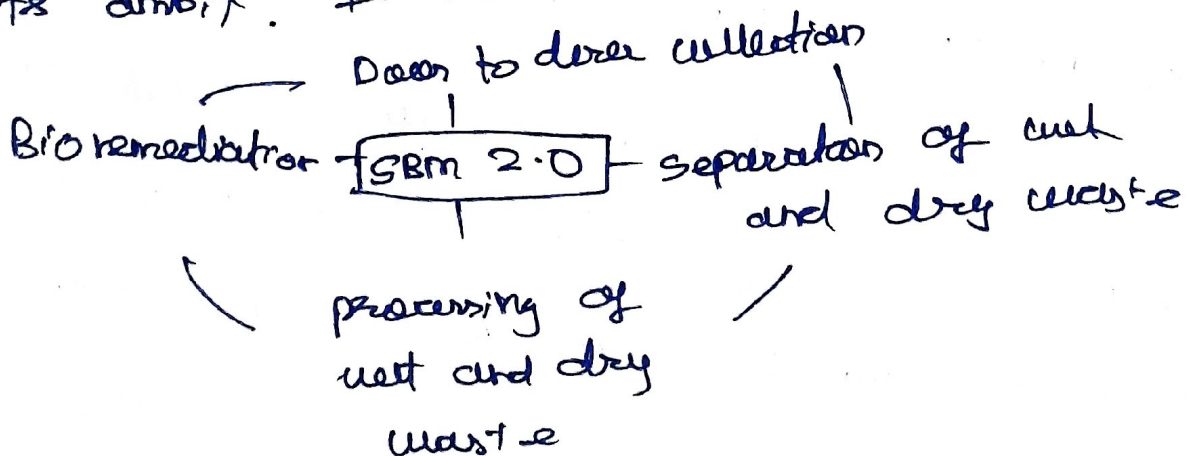
Swachh Bharath 2.0 & 1.0

The SBM (2.0) concentrates on waste management along with the objectives of SBM (1.0). About 1.3 lakh ton/day waste is generated. The SBM 1.0 did not find financial assistance for solid waste management.

Components under 2.0

The SBM 2.0 includes plastic waste, construction and demolition waste under its ambit.

It also includes



Out 1.4 lakh crore allotted in budget. 40,000
crores have been allotted to set up waste
processing units.

- Construction and demolition waste facility
has been introduced in cities with more
than 5 lakh population
- Funding is shared between Centre and states
(states) and additional assistance from the
15th Finance Commission. Centres share will
only include for waste processing

Benefits

The waste processing facilities can produce
72 lakh ton organic compost per year from
48 crore ton waste.

Also, the organic compost from wet
waste can substitute 10-12% fertiliser
consumption saving up to 2300 crore

The states must come forward to
