- The ~~EU~~ European commission and the EU High Representative have set out a Global Gateway Initiative to boost smart, clean and secure links in digital, energy and transport sector as well as to strengthen health and education system across the world.
- From 2021 to 2027, Team Europe (EU Institutions & EU Member States) will mobilise up to €300 billion of investment, primarily targeted towards
 - Digital
 - Climate and energy
 - Transport
 - Health
 - Education and research.

- According to some geopolitical experts the Global Gateway program is coming in the response of China's "Belt & Road Initiative" and large scale economic stoppage due to COVID-19.
- EU is trying its level best to bridge the gap at supply chain, safe data transfer, sustainable ~~Infra~~ by initiating several projects in Latin American countries (EU-LAC) & East Asia.
In Indian Urban Metro Projects EU is making huge investment. Since 1993 € 4.3 Billion have been invested in India.
Brazil & EU are laying optical fibre so that EU can ensure secure & fast data transfer between continents.
- EU's new interest is clearly

visible in reducing dependencies over chinese and american supply chain.
