

New mode of Diplomacy

Safeguarding India's own interest in this highly uncertain and fast changing world needs a new mode of diplomacy.

India ranked 12th in Global Diplomacy Index (2019) compared to China which is first. Being a democratic country with high diversity - religious, linguistic etc India need a new diplomacy to serve following purpose :-

- (i) Border resolutions - Good diplomatic relation has direct manifestation on border conflicts. For example Bhutan & Pakistan, China etc.
- (ii) Hegemony - Diplomacy plays important role to pursue interest without military or economic conflicts. For example US uses hegemony in central Asia.
- (iii) Diaspora - Being largest originator of diaspora diplomacy plays role to safeguard their interest.
- (iv) Economy - trade relations, import-export of goods & service can be enhanced significantly through diplomacy. For example China is using OBOR to become economic power.

working out new diplomacy thus become a need
green to enhance soft skill, India can establish this
through :-

- (i) Domestic policies - safeguarding our minorities, human rights and refugees, achieving environmental commitment etc has direct bear to built good image, which also give chance to criticise others.
- (ii) Deciphering Global talks - is important to understand the direction of air. New and emerging strategic Technology (NEST) is welcome step towards Digital Diplomacy.
- (iii) safeguarding regional issue - By reminding ancient ties like with ASEAN & SAARC, since immediate neighbours are 1st step to for success of diplomacy.
- (iv) balancing military with no military - By brother image sometime hurt India pushing small neighbours like Bangla desha & Nepal towards china, thus balance is important.
- (v) economy - trade relations by reducing tariff since India is at advantageous stage influence diplomacy.
- (vi) multilateralism - Achieving seat in UNSC, playing Active roll in WHO, UNGA etc also enhances position and gives smaller countries an Alternative like during non Allign movement
