③ The recent step to implement NEP, 2020 also aimed at govt. enrolling in vocational training & in higher studies

④ But the reality is, India according to (PLF's report [2020-21]) stated that only 13.8% youths are under vocational training;

- 9% - through informal sources
- 4% - through formal institutions.

⑤ Thus this data shows that India is far more behind to catch up with countries like [S. Korea (90%), US (50%), Germany (75%)]

are under vocational training.

Gap in achieving aim -

① Even the (PLF's) report finds that Among 301 million youths in unemployed India only (13.8%) are employed. (or) received vocational training.

② Further data shows that youths trained in (formal institutions)

→ 27% employed  
→ 56% seeks to work

(informal institutions)

→ 79% employed  
→ 21% seeks to work

So, the rate of youth participation in workforce is higher in informal institutions than formal.


④ Report showcases, 27% of youth are not engaged in (education, training, employment)
