In the Indian Constitution Article 142 allows the Supreme court for discretion to deliver complete justice which has become a Judicial overreach in this case.

Supreme court Judgement $\Rightarrow$ Making copyright infringement an cognisable offence (i.e.) Police can arrest on complaint without court order

Possible Issues of this judgement:

- $\sim$ Demanding copyrights Royalty becoming Extortion of copyrights Royalty
- $\sim$ Lack of training & Knowledge for the Police ~~may result in~~ on copyrights may suppress citizens liberties.

→ No clear understanding of Intellectual property
may lead to unwanted accusation

→ Being a non-Bailable offence can be used by
authority as misuse of power on liberty of
citizens.

→ More petty cases piling on Judicial Table
which lead to further "Delayed Justice"

Since being a judicial decision there are lot
of possibilities for loop holes which can be
abused which is sure to impinge on the
liberty of the citizens.
