



Analyse the various geo-political events that restricted the flexibility in implementation of Foreign Policy of a country.

Geo politics :

Geopolitics is when two or more countries shares a common understanding though separated by geographic barrier and political identity in order to advantage in mutual concern.

Determinants of Geopolitical tie:



Restricted flexibility in implementing foreign policy

of a country

- * Share of common friendly nations in a dispute affect the justice and may lead to nepotism
Eg: Russia favoring India and China in the line of actual control dispute
- * Temporary stability of a disputed region poses relaxed mind set on a region
Eg: Khalistan issue and Pakistan ruling in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir were not evident than that consolidated area due to change in priority.
- * Regional imbalance affecting international priority due to note bank politics.
Eg: Sharing of Hoogly & Teesta river water since a dispute between Bangladesh and India.
- * Third nation influence due to unfriendly relationship with former allies like diplomatic tie.
Eg: India's vote against Indonesia in UN in favour of China.
India's vote against Israel in favour of Palestine issue.

Way forward:

Long sustainable international bonds and robust features strengthen foreign policy even ~~from~~ storms and thunder effects. Change in regime with diplomacy have less role to be played in negative and have high potential to change Geocentrity and multilateral approach seems to be flexible policy
