- It also get power from renewable power rather than from high price thermal power.

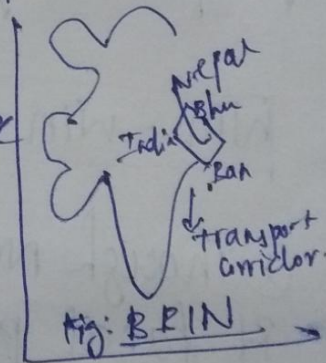
(eg) Ind's 70% of electricity from coal imports.
