

③ Critically analyse the issues in making mother tongue the medium for higher studies in country?

Introduction - NEP, 2020 aimed to promote regional languages in higher education also planned to give instructions in regional languages.

\* As per estimate, 95% of students receive education in their regional languages till their primary education which is mandated according to Art - 350A

Govt's take on Mother tongue as medium -

① Govt ~~is~~ has also taken substantive measures to make engineering studies & subjects in Indian languages.

eg) AICTE granted approval for 19 engineering colleges in 10 states for having courses in Indian languages.

② SWAYAM portal has been launched which is an open course

platform for learning popular courses in Indian languages.

③ Namath Basai by Kerala govt initiative which proved the beneficial outcomes of studies imparted in Indian languages.

④ UGC also promote the regional languages in universities under the scheme "Estb of Centre for regional languages in Central universities".

⑤ Govt should impress judiciary to allow usage of Indian languages in court proceeding to spread the usage of Indian language.

⑥ In UNCRA 2019, regarded as IYL aimed to promote, ~~regional~~ support & preserve usage of indigenous languages.

Way Forward —

① Though impart of Tamil languages in higher

education in Tamil Nadu it didn't create any impact.

② Use of English should be continued wherever desirable, with no aversion on ground of its foreign lang.

③ Countries like FRA, RUSS, CHN, CUBA etc despite having more than 300 lang following 8 of them being the major one in their educational institutions.

④ Impact of Indian languages in education could make students grasp the concept easily & deepen their knowledge.

⑤ This implementation of Vernacular languages in their respective states could improve literacy rates, social inclusion, reduction in poverty & enhance international cooperation.

Conclusion - govt before stepping this initiative it should deeply study both the (adv & disadv) & thereby could achieve their aim of promoting (Indian Lang) in education.
