(ii) India's most of the part having good internet access are not available to connect everyone at home, in which many of students face problem to attend their class regularly basis.

(iii) The digital divide in India's school education system, reflected by the absence of computers and internet access on campus, emerges

- (iv) Many of the students had to rely on
remote learnings, but many faced the
double jeopardy of not possessing their
own computing devices and smartphones at
home, so
- (v) In Northeast India, many had to travel
closer to mobile phone towers to access
the internet on shared phones to get their
lessons.
- (vi) Merely 22% of schools across the
country on average had internet access,
while government institutions fared much
worse at 11%.
- (vii) The national average was 37% and for
government schools, 28.5%.

focus on this situation because this shows all the
basic and knowledgeable education system facing
problem during this condition.
