27th conference of parties, is set to begin in Egypt this month. Already $\frac{4}{5}$ th of global carbon budget has been exhausted. More than half of this, is due to historical emission of CO₂ by developed countries. While several developed countries in COP26 listed their Net zero targets, it is less likely they will less likely to meet even inadequate targets.

Status - After COP26 announcement

1. Global Energy poverty.

- i) 734 million of people in Developing countries - there is no access to electricity.
- ii) 2.6 bn - has no access to clean energy and fuel.
- iii) comparing per capita electricity consumption of 20 poor countries & 20 rich countries there is 85% difference.
