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Montagu - chelmsford Report (MCR) on Indian Constitutional reform is worth to be claimed as the Magna Carta on Modern India. Discuss.

1) Central And State Subjects:

MCR reduced the central control over provinces by separating central and provincial subjects.

Resemblance: Division of Central, state and Concurrent list in the Indian Constitution.

2) Bicameralism:

It introduced Bicameralism and direct election in the country. It replaced Indian Legislative Council by Council of State and Legislative Assembly.

Resemblance: Presence of two Houses Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha in the parliament.

3) Budget:

MCR separated provincial budget from central Budget and authorised Provincial legislature to enact their own Budget.

Resemblance: Announcement of Annual Budget by centre and states

4) Civil Servants:

It provided for establishment of Central public Service Commission for recruiting civil Servants.

Resemblance: Recruitment of civil Servants through Union Public Service Commission and State public Service Commission

5) Responsible Government.

It made the transferred Subjects to be administered by governor with the aid of responsible legislative Council.

Resemblance: The Central government is responsible to the legislative assembly.

As discussed above it can be seen that the MCR was the base of Modern day India and thus it is worth to be called as Magna Carta of Modern India.
