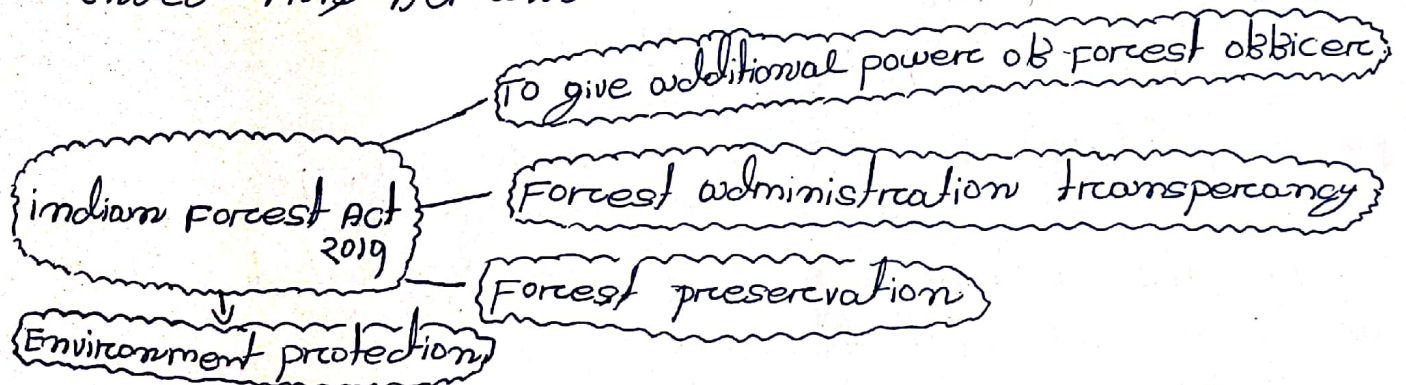

Ans → Indian Forest Act 1927 was created by the colonial government. But this Act reberes to lack of transparency about forest. and forest dwellers suffer various types of difficulties. That's why government of India amended this Act and created Indian Forest Act 2019.



This diagram says that the features of Forest Act 2019.

① To give additional power of forest officer.

This Act provide this power it means the forest officers have power of ~~see~~ search warrant under CrPc 1973. and investigate any place within their jurisdiction.

② Forest administration transparency

The legislature through this Act, special provision for transparency of forest administration. i.e. that

(i) no officers can be involve in corruption.

③ Forest preservation

This Act provide special fund for forest department to preserve the forest like-

(i) re-plantation of tree.

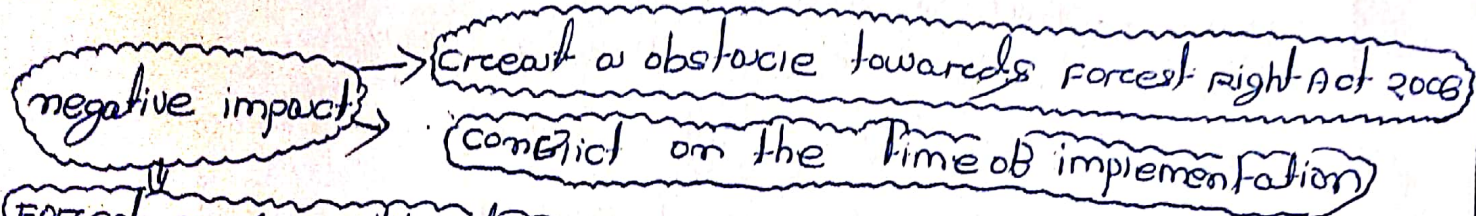
(ii) provide artificial water ~~subsidy~~ subsidy.

④ Environment protection.

man is a social animal so he live in environment.

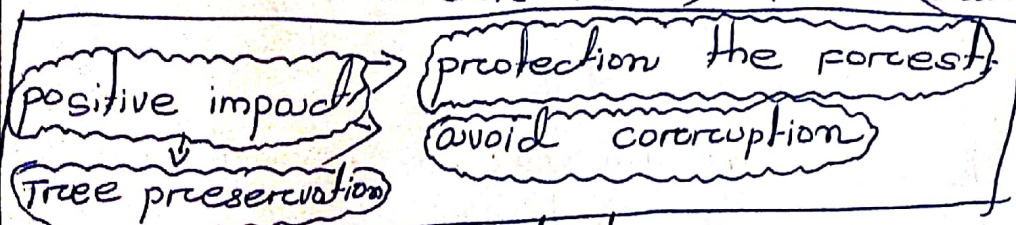
but this indian forest act 2019 give some positive and negative impact.
