National Integration Council - NIC:

1. NIC as Prime Minister as head focus on administering nation to accommodate the multi-cultural, linguistic, religious aspects of India
2. Thus States and Centre through NIC thus preserve the plurality of India by implementing the Cultural Tourism through Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Tourism.



## Sarkaria Commission - 1983:

1. The Commission in its reports mentions about Zonal Councils to be necessarily formed to combat the regional aspirations of the people of India.
2. Result is Home Minister under head of Zonal Council under Re-organisation of States Act - 1956 is success in collaboration regional aspiration in EIA projects across Western Ghats states.

## Inter-State Council:

1. President under A 263 formed ISC which incorporate the borders, aspirations, culture of states for solving disputes between States & Center.
2. (eg) Religious identities in various states are safeguarded ~~and~~ through co-operative federalism of mutual enacting legislations under Article 25.
