ASHA programme initiated from the inspiration on Mitram programme of Chhatisgarh. Volunteers within the community - ASHA women's role was first established in 2005 under National Rural Health Mission.

Issues with the Rural Health care services.

1. Lack of information as a health.

COVID-19 pandemic - example - Lockdown and quarantine is seen by the people as harassment due to lack of information in remote rural areas. The situation asked for channel of communication between Government and the people. ASHA women played vital role. But there is need of system to disseminate life saving information in remote areas.

2. Lack of Resources in rural areas

Di Factors like Distance between the village and hospitals (eg: average 9km), ambulance facility, Lack of medical facilities, Basic Testing facilities eg: HIV, Sickle cell anaemia testing, leading to loss of lives. There is a need for hospital and required facilities at every villages as India approaches 100 years of Independence

2. Current they are recognised as "volunteers". There is a need to formalise their work. This provides dignity, protection and seriousness towards them by State Government, Gram Panchayat & patients.
