- Qb Discuss the challenges in implementing the proposed Women Reservation Bill and the ways to overcome those challenges (250 words)?

Y there is need of Women Reservation Bill :-

- Percentage of Elected Women Representation in India is only 14%.

But in other countries like Bangladesh (20%)
Nepal (30%)

- Acc. to Global Gender Gap Report 2021.
Women ministers are only 9.1% in India
- In the constitution also
 - Art 15(3) - give special provisions for Women
 - Art 325 - equal political right for men & women
- Plus India is also ~~at~~ Ratified many International Agreements.
Hence, India have to obey by them.

Arguments in support :]

- (1) Human Development Indicators will be have positive way out.
- (2) Women Representation will make democracy more representative in Nation.
- (3) It will strengthen women's empowerment
as women's problems can be solved at practical level.
- (4) Women representation will also increase its role in Panchayats and hence grants root level autonomy regarding their political, social and economic rights shall be given.

Arguments Against :]

- (1) This women Reservation Bill might further increases the inequality among women.
- (2) And only women from elite classes might be given representation.
- (3) This might be the case that women Representation can only remain as a proxy. Hence it promotes 'proxy culture'.
- (4) Deserving candidates might lose out as the specific Reservation is provided to women.
- (5) Hence, it might demotivate other ministers to work → Reduces incentives to work.

WAY FORWARD :]

- (1) Provide Reservation in the political parties instead of giving at overall level.
- (2) Candidates Quotas for women should be given at party level.
- (3) We should work on changing the behaviour and change in male dominated value system.
- (4) Awareness and leadership development programmes for women.
