

⇒ India generates 2.4 lakh tonnes of SUP's per annum according to C.P.C.B & per capita SUP's production is of 0.18 kg / year.

The central government has enforced ban on SUP's effectively from 1st of July this year, just banning of SUP's will not be effective until proper monitorings and institutions are formed to carry this channelise this measure.

⇒ According to guidelines ~~order~~ from central government there must be set up of central state level control rooms to work on this

Any use of SUP's such as manufacturing, production, consumption, interstate movement of SUP's is ~~subjected~~ of to is illegal and state can take punitive action.

There ~~is~~ also must be set up of border checkpoints to stop interstate movement of ~~SUP's~~ banned SUP's

⇒ The banned SUP's includes, plastic ice cream sticks, ear bud sticks, plastic cups, bottles, cutlery items, wrappings, polythene bags.

- Plastic used for packaging in the ~~fast~~ fast moving consumer goods sector are not banned will be covered under Extended Producer responsibility guidelines.

EPR is producers responsibility to ensure environmental sound management of the product until the end of its life.

- ⇒ The states must ensure along with following guidelines they have to proactively involve municipal corporations at bare level to check on the ban of SUPs & fine or take punitive action on the society.
- ⇒ Involvement of private institutions, NGOs & societal responsibility ~~is~~ is equally important.
- ⇒ Awareness programs should be set up ~~at~~ at district level & Taluk level boards from respective municipalities.
