→ Initiatives like "Breathe India", "Help Now" has provided array of options to oxygen concentrators and hospitals and ambulances.

→ In Tamil Nadu with help of NGO several districts ~~of~~ have organised "oxygen buses" to provide oxygen to needy patients till they get a bed.

→ Some NGOs provide ~~free~~ free grocery to needy people in addition to government's ration

Way forward

The scope of NITI Aayog DARPAN portal of NGO must be expanded further to ensure better coordination of NGO. This will overcome the asymmetric flow of information. Government experts should partner with an NGO to scale up the efficiency and reduce the cost of operation through cross learning and experience sharing
