Indian Agricultural export reached \$50 billion mark for the first time, which is commendable given pandemic challenges, Russia-Ukraine war, WTO's cases on Pesticide residue on India products etc

Various policy measures that helped

1] cluster development

46 Unique product - district cluster identified for export promotion as part of Agriculture export policy

Ex) Rose Onions clusters - Karnataka  
Banana clusters - Anantapur

2] country specific strategies

Interactions with various stakeholders understand their potential, products & opportunities

3] Virtual meets & trade fair

APEDA initiative developed Virtual catalogues, trade fairs participated by various countries, even Agricells

opened at different embassies of India

#### 4] Product diversification

Expanding agro product basket  
& securing new markets for our  
products

Ex:- Red rice first weigand shipped  
to US

organically certified moong beans

powder to Australia

pomegranate, mango to Serbia etc

#### 5] Resolving issues

Export inspection council testing  
has been made mandatory for Bananas  
export to EU as it complained to WTO  
on Pesticide residue

#### Way Forward

- ✓ Abundant horticultural products  
must be exported as processed food  
which it lacks (white cut off export  
where US - 70% Brazil 30%)
- ✓ Resolving ambiguity in certifying  
organic product as it done by  
FSSAI (for imports), APB DA  
for exports
- ✓ Promote R&D in agriculture  
especially develop high-yield  
seeds, develop pest forecast, reduce  
post harvest losses
