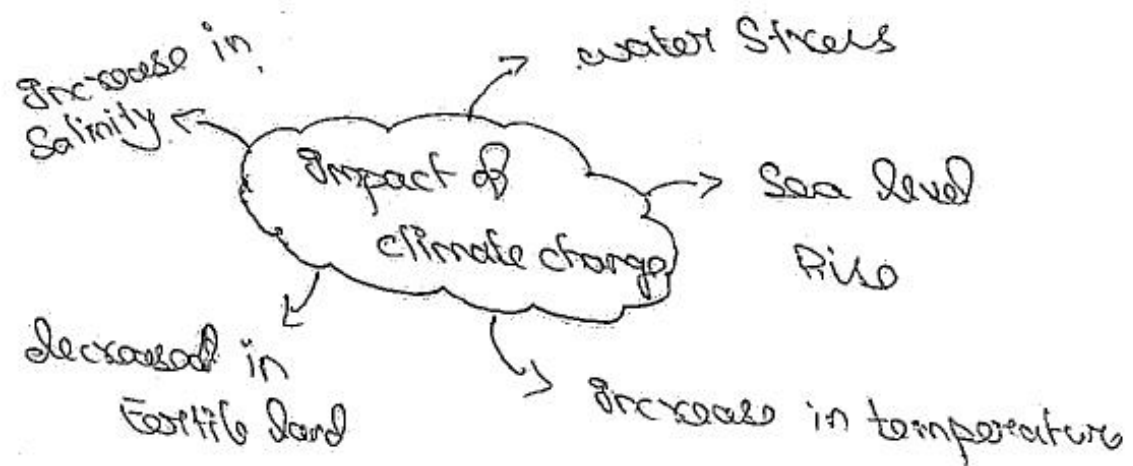


The impact of climate Related food shortages could be more dangerous than that of the covid 19 pandemic. Do you agree with this view? Comment.
