India produces 22% of world's milk production, much of it are used for consumption. India has not able to become a export nation.

Technology boon:

- Indigenous cows yield ~3kg milk per day whereas cross breed yield ~8kg milk per day.
- Cross breeds are capable of increasing many folds.
- Techniques involved
 - ① ~~In~~ In vitro fertilization
 - ② Embryo transfer
 - ③ Artificial Insemination.

- Government has launched National Artificial Insemination program to use the technology for benefit
- This is capable of enhancing yield of 1,099 kg per year to 3,000 kg per year from cross breeds.
- Issue with Artificial Insemination is it requires finding heat and timely transfer.
- In vitro fertilization has other promising benefits - its efficiency is quite higher.
- It requires investment in infrastructure

India wants to double farmers income it can achieve it by leveraging this opportunity.
