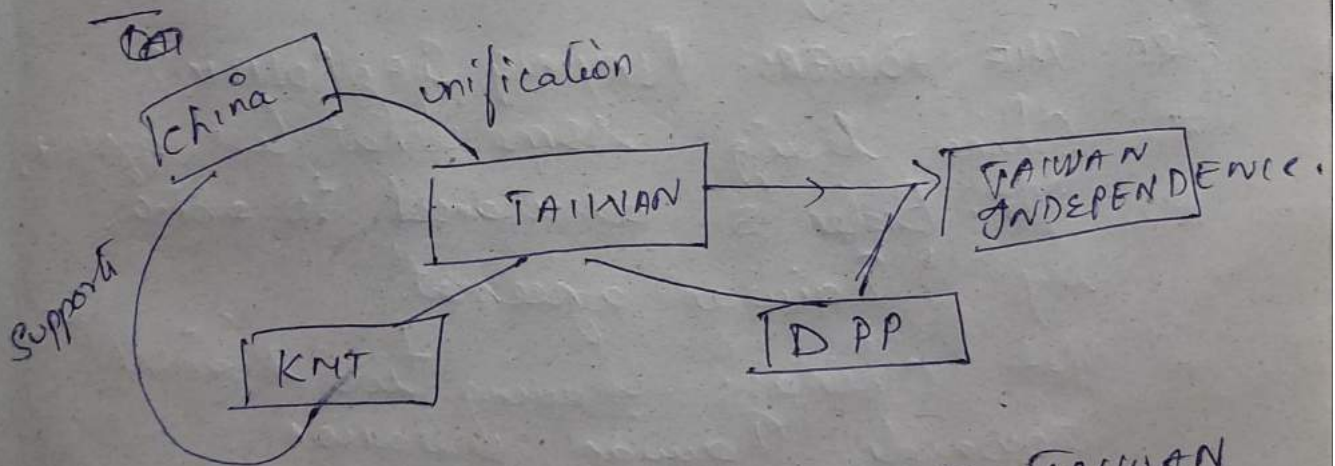


Yes, Pursuing its Indo Pacific Strategy, India needs to be mindful of the geo politics of major power in the region.
