This was brought out by
the government to import good
governance in sports bodies without
interfering in their autonomy.
Certain individuals, especially politicians
hold term for long time affecting
governance.

Violation.

Sports bodies that violate are
put under CoA, which was the
case recently in AIFF, Hockey, and
table tennis federations. In some cases, funding
might be cut off, derecognition by sports ministry.

Issues.

- Vested interest in the governance of sports bodies
- Different conceptions of democracy.
- Issues regarding members of Council, right to vote, who
to stand in elections.

Autonomy

For both national and International bodies autonomy is the key so that they can focus on their primary interest i.e. sports - to give opportunities for everyone to fulfil their potential.

Way ahead

→ CoA was of the view that only if athletes are given representation democratically. But it will function if athletes are equipped with skills to administer federations.

→ District level and state level athletes should be set up with commission and experienced retired and adequately.

→ Sufficient representation then can be imparted at the national level.

→ Transparent election authority can be set up to independent stakeholders with different mechanism and matters of internal functioning.

look into → International federation should function effectively to avoid governance layer.
