has pushed the rural population into
social, economical and health distress. Urgent
response is needed from the government to overcome
distress.

Social and Economical distress

The Hungerwatch report
held atleast 70% of rural respondents borrowed
money for food and around 45% skipped a meal
in October 2020. The Centre for Monitoring
Indian Economy - think tank constituted unemployment
rate in rural around 26%.

To mitigate this Government
~~announced~~ announced 5 kg free food grain for
month may and June under National Food Security
Act. Around ₹73,000 Crore were allotted to
MGNREGA Scheme to meet the economic distress

Government could reintroduce the PM Gaurib Kalyan Package to effectively neutralise the distress. Further extra fund can be allotted to MGNREGA Scheme to meet up ground demand

Health distress

Rural population due to lack of awareness highly affected by pandemic.

Government through Awareness campaigns at Panchayati level could make people in rural aware of mitigation measures like vaccination drive, oxygen buses, Cowin registration portal etc.

Further through multifrontal approach government needs to take measures for children like making available education free, for informal workers like providing them jobs and making use of them for awareness measures.

Government could use this pandemic time to upgrade and update details about informal workers who dominate the rural area which will help in effective implementation of Industrial Codes and Acts introduced in 2020, codify and ensure speedy recovery of economy of rural
