


The Supreme Court's digitalisation vision is expected to improve access to justice in country. Substantiate (200 words)

- As the flow of case is fully digitised and in a unified platform judges ~~can~~ will be able to deliver better judgements.
- Since hearings can be digital the cost of procedure for all people is same as they are able to access justice from anywhere.
This improves inclusivity.
