→ Swami Vivekananda renowned as the God-man during the British India gave call for the equality in society.

He termed social evils such as untouchability and Varna system as weakness in the society which gave impetus to many Indians to participate in national movement.

→ According to their motto helping poor and needy was objective and Swami Vivekananda found Poverty, Squalor were prevalent in the society and urged the countrymen to work against them.
