However Election Commission of India recently rejected YSRCP's ~~re~~ elected permanent president, terming it as Anti-Democratic & insisting no individual should be elected leader for life.

Even though some of National parties like BJP, CPI-M conducts regular presidential election & organized cadres majority of regional parties dominated by families, without internal democracy.

Election Commission of India used guidelines issued for registration of party and Section 29A of RPA 1951 & remind parties to conduct election & renew leadership row after every 5 year however it does not have statutory power

However some political parties argue election to political leadership amounts to factions, hatred b/w leaders & results party disintegration however U.S & UK presidential election are good example for election for leadership within party.

As every practice of any value or principles start with Home, political parties must devoid idea of permanent leadership & pursue internal democracy before uphold 'Constitutional spirit of DEMOCRACY'.
