### Social Impacts in South Asian Region

The GAME report says that around 390 million women living in low and middle income countries do not have internet access.

In South Asian Region only 65% women own a ~~cell~~ cellphone.

The digital divide deepens in cases like these resulting inequitable access to basic needs.

Eg: CoWIN app for vaccine registration requires internet and mobile phone - this neglects women from access to healthcare

Secondly as education is ~~also~~ through online it also denies education access.
